MdBioLab aims to provide a safe learning environment for students, teachers, and all guests who come on-board. As such, we ask that you help us enforce MdBioLab's Safety Rules and Regulations:

- 1) Each student must sign a release form before entering the MdBioLab. We ask that you give signed release forms to the MdBioLab instructors before your students enter the truck. Teachers are responsible for ensuring that all students aboard the truck have signed and returned these forms.
- 2) Students are expected to wear closed toed shoes on-board the MdBioLab. Students should also tie back long hair.
- 3) Goggles and gloves, which will be provided by the MdBioLab, should be worn at all times.
- 4) Food, drink, and gum are prohibited on the MdBioLab when classes are being taught.
- 5) Because space on the truck is limited, we require that all students leave personal items (books, backpacks, coats, etc.) behind in the classroom. Students only need to bring their activity handouts with them.
- 6) It is of utmost priority to ensure that there is no horseplay amongst students due to limited space and the presence of potentially harmful materials on the truck. Any student jeopardizing the safety of any of the other students, teachers, or instructors on the MdBioLab will be asked to leave.
- 7) The MdBioLab is an extension of the classroom lab and any rules that apply inside the school will apply on the MdBioLab as well.
